Our Program

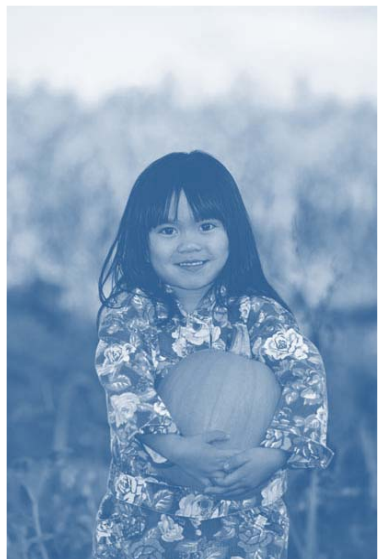
