Safety and Security

Ultimately, we know our safety lies in the Lord's hands. We are thankful He has faithfully provided all we need as a school to provide a quality, Christian education for the past 36 years. Much has changed in education over this time and, like owning a home, the time has come to upgrade our facility. The school's Safety Committee has been working diligently to



assess areas in need of improvement. Top on that list is the necessity to bring the school up to Safety and Security Standards. In order for students to thrive and learn, education must take place in a safe, secure and positive learning environment. Toward that end, we are looking to upgrade both interior and exterior hardware, upgrade our security system, and add additional improvements to raise the level of safeguards on campus.

Interior Doors

The interior doors of the school present the first priority in upgrading the facility. The school currently has a wide variety of hardware installed on classroom doors. Replacing this hardware with a standardized lock will enable school personnel to lock doors with a universal key regardless of where they are located. We are planning to install forty-six intruder locks on classroom doors as well as the office and common areas. This will provide the most current security lock available on the market for our classrooms.

Exterior Doors

A recent assessment of the facility revealed the exterior doors to the school need to be upgraded. The entrance door and both sets of the main gym doors are in need of replacement. Other exterior doors are in need of repair. These improvements will significantly aid in the security and efficiency of the building. Heating costs are expected to diminish as the building becomes more air tight. These doors must be repaired or replaced before the new electronic locking system can be installed.



Digital Security Camera Systems



Although the school currently utilizes a security camera system, an updated quality control system will provide additional security to our campus. This new equipment records all video events in public areas and provides live monitoring of the campus. This nineteen camera digital system runs off a central monitor giving real time color surveillance of the campus.

Electronic Door System

The electronic door system provides access to the facility to authorized personnel and secures the building to potential intruders. The controller provides 100 percent intelligence at each door and provides an audit trail of users of the entrance doors.
