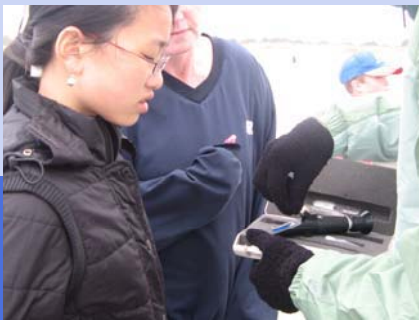


Fifth grade Field Trip to the Wetland's Institute, Stone Harbor, NJ
