

SUPPLIES FOR 4TH GRADE

Dear Parents,

Thank you for entrusting us with your child's education this year. We have a lot of exciting things planned, and will be learning much! Please keep these papers for future reference.

Please print your child's name on the outside cover of each of your child's books. Also, label your child's lunchbox, sweaters, jackets, coats, supplies etc. This helps so much when things are lost or misplaced.

Thank you for your cooperation in obtaining the following school supplies.

1. 1 Composition Book
2. 2 Packs of Notebook paper - Wide ruled is better for 4th graders. More will need to be purchased during the school year as the need arises.
3. 3 Dozen #2 pencils
4. 2 Big erasers - not scented or toy shaped please
5. Crayons - 24 count will be sufficient
6. Small set of colored pencils
7. 1 glue stick - no liquid glue, please. Also label with child's name.
8. Scissors
9. Small case or pencil box
10. 3 boxes of tissues - large inexpensive boxes will do.
11. Ruler - 12 inches long with both English and Metric measurements
12. Two 1½" notebooks - 1 for leaf project, 1 for NJ Notebook
13. 1 container of Clorox wipes
14. A lunch - each child should come to school with a lunch every day. Please no gum or soda or drinks in glass bottles.
15. Sneakers with light colored soles - These will be used daily for recess and gym.
16. School sweater and jacket or coat - As the days get cooler these items will be a necessity. Students without adequate outside wear on cold days will not be permitted to go outside for recess time.
17. Assignment Book - TPA approved - Will be given out at registration or on the first day of school by the classroom teacher.
